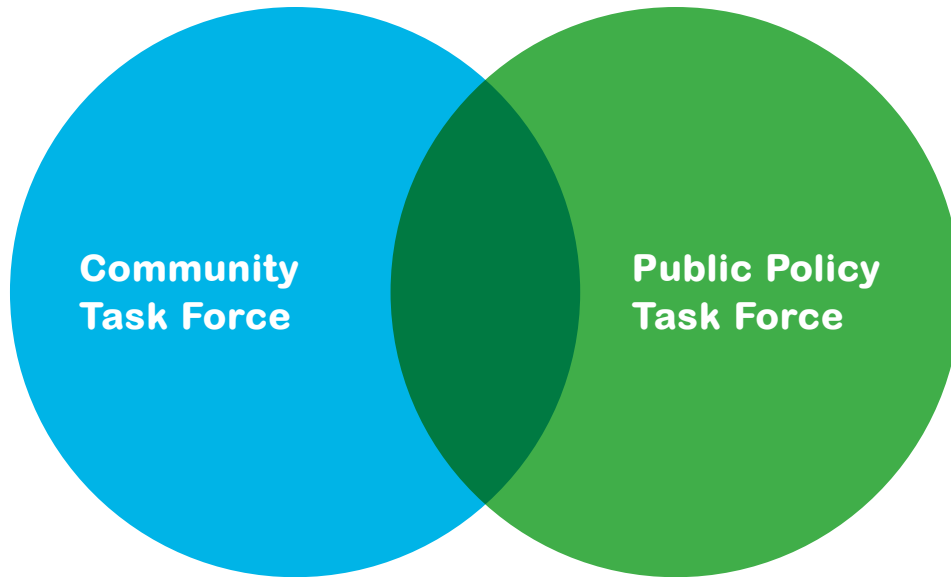

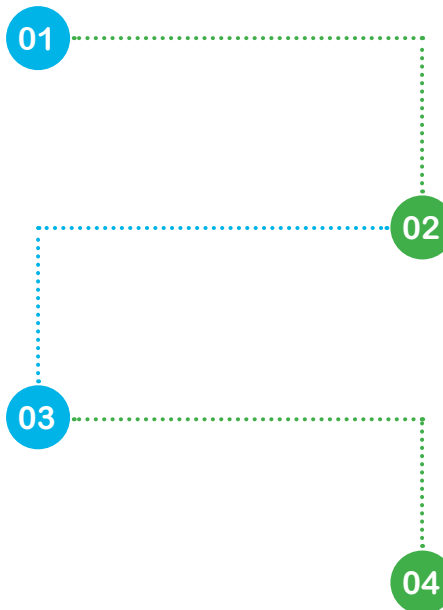


IDENTIFY ISSUES

The Community Task Force and the Public Policy Task Force identify and prioritize the top concerns of the community at the local, state and national level.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Jointly, the Community Task Force and the Public Policy Task Force develop a plan to educate and mobilize residents and stakeholders around the issues.



POLICY SOLUTION

The Public Policy Task Force then researches the issues identified and creates policy recommendations with input from BCAC staff, non-profit organizations, community leaders and other stakeholders. The Community Task Force considers the impact of policy proposals on the community.

POLICY ADVOCACY

Both Task Forces work with BCAC staff to advocate for policy change with local, state and federal elected officials and agencies.
